

CLEP PLACEMENT

Credit for some courses may be earned through CLEP. Recent high school graduates as well as those who have acquired knowledge in ways other than through traditional classroom attendance may benefit from these tests. Credit is granted only for the subject exams listed below; no more than 30 credits can be earned through CLEP. Credit will be designated as earned by CLEP on the permanent record and indicated as an S grade (satisfactory), and therefore will not affect the student's quality point average.
