# Marquette University Voter ID Card

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**Certification:** By completing and signing the application and presenting it for the issuance of a Marquette University Voter ID Card, I am in fact the person whom I claim to be on the front of this application. I am at least eighteen (18) years of age. I am registered as a student at Marquette University at the time of submitting this application for a Marquette University Voter ID Card. I am not a visiting student or MIAD-registered or high school registered student who is attending classes at Marquette University. I am currently a resident in the district or ward in Wisconsin where I intend to use the Marquette University Voter ID Card to establish my identity as part of the exercise of my right to vote under Wisconsin law and have been a resident there for at least twenty-eight (28) consecutive days prior to the time that I submitted this application for a Marquette University Voter ID Card. I am a citizen of the United States of America, and I am currently not serving a sentence for a felony conviction.

**The Card:** The Marquette University Voter ID Card is intended to be used for two (2) years from the date of issuance. It is not necessary to obtain a new card each academic term or academic year. In order to receive a Marquette University Voter ID Card, you must present a valid regular MarquetteCard and be registered for classes. No other forms of identification will be accepted. The Marquette University Voter ID Card is non-transferable and may only be used for the purpose of establishing your identity while exercising your rights as a voter in Wisconsin. Receipt of the Marquette University Voter ID Card does not mean that you are registered to vote, which can only be accomplished pursuant to Wisconsin law, or that you are in fact entitled to vote in Wisconsin.

**Liability for Lost or Stolen Card:** If a Marquette University Voter ID Card is lost or stolen, the cardholder is responsible for all charges associated with its replacement, which is the same charge as for replacing a regular MarquetteCard.

**Privacy/Disclosure of Account Information to Third Parties:** The university will disclose information related to the Marquette University Voter ID Card to third parties only (1) in order to comply with subpoenas, court orders or other applicable legal requirement or (2) if the account holder gives written permission.
