Sign-In Process

1. Call the Fitness Assessment Center to schedule an appointment at:
The Rec Center – 288-5624
The Rec Plex – 288-3275
2. The Fitness Assessment attendant will take the appointment and send a confirmation email to the non-member.
3. Bring the email, along with an MU-ID card to the Main Office of either the Rec Center or the Rec Plex about 5-10 minutes before the scheduled appointment.
4. Show MU-ID and sign in to the guest book and proceed back to the FAC for the screening.
