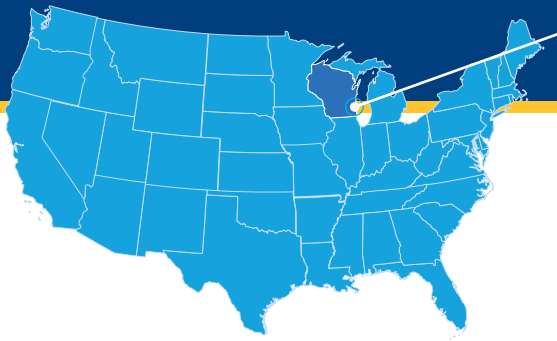


# Marquette University

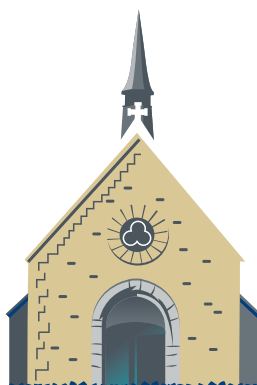
