

CCRC Minutes March 10, 2010

Attendance: Drs. Monahan (director), Acord, Curran, Mattox, Mynlieff, Peterson, Taylor, Uglan, Fr. Zeps, Ms. Coan, Messrs. Geiser, and Meus.

The meeting was called to order at 3:35 p.m.

Reflection was offered by Chris Geiser.

Minutes from February 10, 2010, were discussed and clarified. A motion to accept the clarified minutes was made by Mr. Geiser, seconded by Dr. Mattox. Minutes were unanimously approved as clarified.

New Business

The application of WGST 1001 to the Individual and Social Behavior core knowledge area was discussed. A motion was made by Dr. Curran to have the application revised and that it be resubmitted expeditiously so that it could be included in the next undergraduate bulletin, if approved, seconded by Dr. Acord. The motion was approved unanimously.

Old Business

Dr. Monahan stated that the training of graduate students to aid with the ICLO rating should take no longer than six hours. Dr. Peterson suggested Dr. Factor as an invaluable resource to assist with training the graduate students.

A subcommittee, made up of Drs. Mattox, Monahan, Mynlieff, and Ms. Coan, was formed to draft a proposed policy for the review of core courses.

A discussion ensued concerning the evaluation of transfer credits. The discussion focused on developing a procedure for accepting transfer credits that would be simpler, more concrete, and consistent.
