You can. The Ignacio Ellacuría, S.J. Dreamers Scholarship provides partial need-based scholarship to Marquette's undocumented students. Most undocumented youth were brought to the United States by their families at a young age, grow up attending American schools, and believing in the American dream. But for many undocumented students, no matter how hard they work, their dream of college is out of reach.



These young men and women are not eligible for federal financial aid as this requires citizenship or legal permanent residency. The result is that, of the 65,000 undocumented students who graduate from high school each year, only about 5-10% will attend a postsecondary institution.¹

They are, however, eligible for many Marquette University scholarships. And this year, students will once again lead the effort to raise funds for the Ignacio Ellacuría, S.J. Dreamers Scholarship for undocumented students at the Fourth Annual Dreamers Gala: *Dare to Dream*. With the generosity of the community in previous years, this effort has raised over \$100,000 so far, enabling us to endow the scholarship and ensure its impact for years to come! But the need is still great. Can you support our talented undocumented students at this year's gala?
