SCHOOL/ ORGANIZATION (Christ the King Jesuit College Prep, Chicago, IL):

DESCRIPTION: The Christ the King Jesuit Volunteer Program connects recent college graduates who wish to serve in low-income communities with the opportunity to work in an innovative educational environment. Christ the King Jesuit, a member of the Cristo Rey Network was established to provide working families of Chicago's West Side the opportunity for a safe, faith-based, affordable Jesuit, college preparatory education. Volunteers are an integral part of the school and community, serving in the classroom and outside of it in a number of roles. In exchange for their service, volunteers receive housing, a monthly salary stipend, grocery stipend and bonus upon completion of 2 years of service.

Necessary Qualifications:

- Desire to learn a variety of roles in an innovative educational environment.
- Ability to work in a fast paced, always changing environment
- Commitment to Jesuit education and Ignatian Pedagogy
- Bachelor's degree
