## **Study Abroad Course Selection for Engineering Majors**

(Updated: 9/26/22)

Studying abroad is possible for engineering students. It requires careful planning. Engineering students typically study abroad in the spring or summer of sophomore year. The course lists provided in this guide are intended for students planning for spring sophomore year study abroad.

### **Study Abroad Course Approval Form:**

After acceptance into the study abroad program, students must complete and submit a <u>"Study Abroad Course Approval"</u> form. All potential courses the student may consider taking while abroad – including alternate courses – should be listed. Use more than one form if necessary. Please schedule an advising appointment to discuss course approvals with Dr. Federle. Completed forms should be sent to Dr. Federle at <u>mark.federle@MU.edu</u> for final approval.

#### Advising and Registering for Courses the Semester After You Study Abroad:

The Opus College of Engineering requires students to meet each semester with their academic advisor during the academic advising period (after midterm grades are available). Communication with academic advisors is expected to be done via Teams or email. Students should include a list of classes (MU equivalent course numbers) that they are currently taking while abroad and a list of classes they plan on enrolling in the following semester.

#### "Register in a Class Without a Required Pre-Requisite" form:

If students are taking a course while abroad that is a pre-requisite for a course they plan on taking in the following semester, they must complete a <u>"Register in a Class Without a Required Pre-Requisite" form</u>, which is available on the MU Central website. Students should submit the form to <u>coe-records@MU.edu</u> and if approved the student will be enrolled in the class. Transfer credit must be earned for the pre-requisite course prior to the start of the term in which the student is registered for the courses requiring said pre-requisite.

Students should declare their preferred Discovery Tier Theme prior to studying abroad. This can be done via Checkmarq, following these instructions.

Note: For students who participate in a full-time (12 credits or more) Marquette approved study abroad program, one study abroad course may fulfill the elective requirement of the Discovery Tier. Up to two primary major courses may double-count for non-foundation tier courses. If a course double counts for an engineering major requirement and a non-foundation tier course, any resulting credit deficiency must be satisfied to complete the minimum degree credit requirements.
