- **Best Foundations in Rhetoric Essay** (6-8 pages).
- **Best Undergraduate Writing in Non-Fiction** (including Creative Nonfiction and Rhetoric and Composition) (up to 15 pages).
- Best Undergraduate Writing About Literature (up to 15 pages).
- Best Undergraduate Writing in Poetry (ten poem maximum)
- **Best Undergraduate Writing in Fiction** (up to 15 pages).

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: MARCH 18, 5pm HOW TO SUBMIT:

- -- Double space your work (poetry can be single-spaced).
- --Your name should NOT appear anywhere on the manuscript itself. The title of the work you're submitting should go on the top of the first page.
- --Include a cover sheet with your name, email address, the title of the work you're submitting, and the category for which you're submitting.
- --For the Non-Fiction Prize, multi-modal work that incorporates visuals, audio, and/or video can be submitted.
