

## **What is the Net Price Calculator?**

The Net Price Calculator (NPC) is a tool for families to use to determine the estimated costs of a Marquette education. Families will enter their financial information (earnings, savings, other investments) and will receive an estimate on what they can expect to pay for their first year at Marquette. It is an informal FAFSA. To be considered for need based aid, we ask our undocumented and DACA students to complete this form.

## **Where do I find the NPC and how do I submit it?**

## **What does Marquette do with the information I submit?**

All information is strictly confidential. By entering your families' financial information and submitting proof of income, we will be able to come up with an "Expected Family Contribution" (EFC). We will use this number to determine how much aid you may be eligible for.

## **When can I submit my NPC?**

Please do not submit until **after you have been admitted**.

## **What kind of "proof of income" do I need to submit?**

**You will not be reviewed for aid from Marquette until you submit BOTH the NPC AND proof of income.** Most students will submit their parents' taxes (1040 form) from the "prior prior" year (e.g., for Fall 2021 admits, complete the NPC using your parents' 2019 tax information).

If your parents do not file taxes, please contact Marquette Central to find out what other documents you may be able to submit.

## **How do I submit my proof of income documents?**

You will upload documents to your CheckMarq account. [You can find instructions here.](#)

## **How do I access my CheckMarq account?**

Your CheckMarq credentials were sent to the e-mail address you listed in your application around the time you received your admission decision. If you cannot find this e-mail or are unable to log in, contact Marquette IT Services at 414-288-7799 to have your password reset.

## **Can I complete the NPC in Spanish?**

## **Why is it asking for my academic information?**

In addition to providing an estimate on how much your family can contribute to your Marquette education, the form also attempts to estimate how much a student may receive in scholarship. As an admitted student, you will already have your scholarship amount listed in your acceptance letter.

## **Where do I find the information to complete the income section?**

If your parents file taxes, their 1040 forms will be the easiest place to find the necessary information.

If your parents do not file taxes, estimate or provide numbers from other proof of income documents.

## **The form asks what my income was – what if I do not work?**

Enter 0s for all answers if you as the student do not earn any income.

## **I have my results. What do I do now?**

Send the email results to your personal email, then forward the results to [Yarlian.vazquez@marquette.edu](mailto:Yarlian.vazquez@marquette.edu).

## **What happens now?**

Our financial aid office will process this form and will consider you for a Marquette Grant with the data provided. If you apply for any scholarships (which we strongly encourage) that list FAFSA completion as a requirement, we'll use this form in place of the FAFSA.
