This form should be used by ALL Marquette graduate students who submit a thesis or dissertation. It will allow you to select "Traditional Publishing" through ProQuest and "Open Access" through the repository, *e-Pubs*, run by Marquette University's Raynor Memorial Library. The library will publish your thesis or dissertation through Open Access Publishing at no additional cost.

Open Access is the broadest possible method of disseminating your work. Granting open access to your thesis or dissertation results in more recognition of your research work, wider dissemination of scholarly information, and acceleration of research. Open Access publishing through *e-Pubs* does not diminish your copyright as the author of the work in any way.

Note that any of the four Open Access Publishing options will eventually allow your work to be viewed by anyone, anywhere. The Embargo options, if chosen, simply delay the access to your work - it will not be available to anyone for the period of the embargo. Restricted Publishing will limit your work to the Marquette campus in perpetuity or until such time that you request the restriction be lifted.

If you want to make your work completely unavailable for a period of time, then select one of the Embargo periods. If you want to allow your work to be immediately available, but only to the Marquette campus community, then select Restricted Publishing. If you want your work to be immediately available to anyone, anywhere, select Open Access – No Embargo.

Open Access Publishing - No Embargo
