U-PASS (Milwaukee Country Transit Pass for students)

Graduate Students can enroll in the U-Pass program for fall. The U-Pass must be purchased directly at Union Station, AMU 158. The deadline for current U-Pass holders who have opted into the program and no longer wish to utilize the U-Pass must opt-out by Tuesday, Sept. 6. As a reminder, the fee for continuing U-Pass holders is added to the student's bursar account.

Loyalty 50 Dining Plan

This plan is available to all faculty, staff and students not living in a residence hall, so if you are living in an apartment, commuting from home, are a graduate student or work on campus, you are eligible for this plan. This plan will allow you 50 meals or swipes at any of the traditional dining halls or destination dining establishments on campus.
