

**College of Health Sciences Students:
How to Access and Review Your Degree Progress Report for Advising**

In Checkmarq, click on the “Degree Progress” tile:



Once there, click on “View Degree Progress Report” button. A PDF report will be generated.
Note – you may need to disable pop-up blockers in your browser to view the report.



PREPARATION FOR YOUR ADVISING MEETING

Completion of all degree requirements for graduation is YOUR responsibility. If you have any questions about your graduation checklist, please discuss with your advisor during your advising session.

Use the following guidelines to review your Degree Progress Report:

- Verify that your EGT (Expected Graduation Term) is correct. Your EGT is the term in which you plan to **complete all degree requirements**, not when you plan to participate in the graduation ceremony:

If your EGT is incorrect, you can email your correct EGT to barbara.burja@marquette.edu or note the correct EGT on your advising survey and talk to your advisor about it during your advising meeting.

- Research graduate/professional programs of interest to identify prerequisites that you need to take.
- If you have junior standing or higher, we strongly recommend that you develop a semester-by-semester plan to ensure completion of all degree requirements in your remaining semesters.
- Complete the CHS Advising Survey sent to your Marquette email after midterm grades are posted. This will walk you through the process of preparing for advising.
- Forward the email generated by your completed CHS Advising Survey to your academic advisor and attach a copy of your Degree Progress Report.
