At Marquette University, pre-health is an intent, not a specific major. This allows you to choose from a wide variety of majors and then work with a pre-health adviser to identify prerequisites and application timelines for your pre-health career path and goals. Our pre-health advisers work with MU students with a variety of interests including medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, physician assistant studies, physical therapy, public health, occupational therapy, and more.

Why Pre-Health at Marquette University?

- Interdisciplinary core curriculum ensures a well-rounded education: The Marquette Core Curriculum (MCC) requires students to select courses from a broad range of disciplines and to examine themes from multiple perspectives. Being wellrounded academically is not only valued by health professional programs, but is also helpful on admission tests (i.e., MCAT, DAT, etc.) and in the interview process.
- Opportunities to participate in cutting edge research:
 Undergraduate students have opportunities to work with distinguished research faculty through a variety of programs including Disciplinary Honors, Summer Research Program, independent study, research internships and volunteer or paid positions.
- Accelerated tracks: Complete undergraduate and advanced degrees up to a year earlier than completing both degrees separately. These accelerated programs have very competition admissions processes and are available for OT, PT, PA, DENT, PharmD (at MCW),.
- Other unique opportunities to enhance your MU experience:
 - Bioethics Internship at MCW
 - Health-related minors: Spanish for the Health Professions; Health Studies; Culture, Health and Illness; Health Communication
 - Global Brigades service trips to Central America (medical, dental and public health)
