Summary

The Department of Occupational Therapy and On Your Marq (OYM) will develop a cross-campus multidisciplinary collaboration to successfully transition Marquette University (MU) students with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) to off-campus, community living. This program will specifically focus on functional achievement in daily living skills and community participation. Programming will be personcentered and developed to align with an individual's preferred occupations, interests, strengths, and community needs for transitioning from the college living environment to adult living.

 - Fall 2021: utilize individualized assessment to achieve independent functioning
- Year 2
 - Create training modules
- Year 3
 - Devise a student toolkit
