History:

1890s-1958	First Oblates of Mary Immaculate (Canada) and then Jesuits (formerly Turin, Canadian, and California; now Oregon Province, Portland, Oregon) visited the Koyukuk River District stations (Koyukon) from St. Peter's, Nulato
1958-1980, 1987-1998	Jesuits established and attended St. Patrick Mission (Koyukon) from Our Lady, Nulato
1954-1963, 1982-1987	Jesuits attended St. Patrick's from St. John's, Galena
1970-1973	Jesuits attended St. Patrick's from St. Aloysius, Tanana
1984-1989	A Sister of Notre Dame served St. Patrick's
1989-2002	Became a parish; A Franciscan brother (Sacred Heart Province, St. Louis, Missouri) administered St. Patrick Church
2004-present	A lay administrator has administered St. Patrick's with a diocesan priest attending from St. John's, Galena
