History:

By 1914-1970	Jesuits (formerly California; now Oregon Province, Portland, Oregon) established and attended Immaculate Heart of Mary/ Church of Mary, the Mother of God (Eskimo) from St. Lawrence, Mountain Village
1970s-1990s	Jesuits attended Immaculate Heart from Immaculate Conception, Bethel
1990s-present	Became a parish; Jesuits have administered Immaculate Heart assisted by permanent deacons (Eskimo)

Jesuits from Immaculate Heart have attended the following Eskimo station and mission:

1914-present	Pilot Station; attended alternately by St. Lawrence, Mountain Village; Our Lady of Guadalupe, Russian Mission; and Church of Mary, Marshall
2000-present	Our Lady of Guadalupe Mission, Russian Mission
