History:

1917-1950	Jesuits (formerly California; now Oregon Province, Portland, Oregon) established and attended St. Theresa Mission (Dena'ina) from Immaculate Conception, Fairbanks
1950s	Jesuits attended St. Theresa's from Holy Rosary, Tok Junction
1960-1963	Jesuits attended St. Theresa's from Immaculate Conception, Fairbanks
1966-1971, 1984-1988	Became a parish (officially in 1970); diocesan priests administered St. Theresa Church
1971-1983, 1989	Jesuits administered St. Theresa's
1989-1991	Dominican Sisters (Edmonds Congregation of Holy Cross, Edmonds, Washington) administered St. Theresa's
1991- 2002	Marist Missionary Sisters (North American Province, Waltham, Massachusetts) administered St. Theresa's
2003-present	A lay administrator and a visiting priest, from Holy Mary of Guadalupe, Healy, have administered St. Theresa's
