History:

1912-after 1915	Jesuits (formerly California; now Oregon Province, Portland, Oregon) established and administered St. Peter in Chains Mission (Koyukon)
ca. 1919-1959	Jesuits attended St. Peter's from St. Peter Claver's, Nulato
1960-1966, 1973-1980	Jesuits attended St. Peter's from St. John's, Galena
1966-1973	Jesuits attended St. Peter's from St. Aloysius, Tanana
1980-1987	St. Columbans Foreign Mission Society (American Region, St. Columbans, Nebraska) attended St. Peter's from St. John's, Galena
1983-1988	Dominican Sisters ministered to St. Peter in Chains
1987-present	Became a parish; Franciscans (Sacred Heart Province, St. Louis, Missouri) have administered St. Peter in Chains Church
1988-1990	A Sister of Notre Dame ministered to the parish
