| 1904-1910 | Jesuits (formerly Turin, Canada, and California; now Oregon Province, Portland, Oregon) attended Stebbins/ Steben station (Eskimo) from St. Michael's, St. Michael |
| 1908-1918 | Jesuits established and attended St. Bernard Mission (Eskimo) from St. Michael's, St. Michael |
| 1918-1919 | Became a parish; Jesuits administered St. Bernard Church |
| 1919-1999 | Jesuits attended St. Bernard's from St. Michael's, St. Michael |
| 1999-present | A lay administrator has administered St. Bernard's assisted by permanent deacons (Eskimo) |
