1904-present                      Franciscans (formerly St. John the Baptist Province, Cincinnati, Ohio; now Our Lady of Guadalupe Province, Albuquerque, New Mexico) established and have administered Our Lady of Fatima Church/ Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church (Navajo), Chinle, Navajo Reservation

Franciscans from Our lady of Fatima have attended the following Navajo Indian missions on the Navajo Reservation:

1905-present                      St. Anthony Mission, Many Farms  
1981-present                      St. Mary of the Rosary Mission, Pinon

Inclusive dates: 1880-present
