Access: Some restrictions apply

History: Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church is a non-Indian parish that had a few Pima Indian parishioners before 1940. Diocesan priests from Assumption attended the following Indian missions and stations:

1873-1890s	Gila River (Pima) and Salt River Reservation stations (Pima)
1882-1883 (transferred to Immaculate Heart, Phoenix)	Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church (Pima and Yaqui), Tempe
1902-1910 (transferred to St. John's, Laveen)	St. Anthony Mission (Pima), Sacaton, Gila River Reservation
