History: Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church is a non-Indian parish that had a few Pima Indian parishioners before 1940. Diocesan priests from Assumption attended the following Indian missions and stations:

1873-1890s

1882-1883 (transferred to Immaculate Heart, Phoenix)
1902-1910 (transferred to St. John's, Laveen)

Gila River (Pima) and Salt River
 Reservation stations (Pima)
Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church (Pima
 and Yaqui), Tempe
St. Anthony Mission (Pima), Sacaton,
 Gila River Reservation
