History of St. Lucy Mission, San Lucy

1885-1914	Diocesan priests established and attended St. Lucy/ Ss. Simon and Jude Mission (Tohono O'odham), San Lucy/ Paloma Ranch/ Gila Bend from Immaculate Conception, Phoenix
1915	Franciscans (St. John the Baptist Province, Cincinnati, Ohio) attended St. Lucy's from St. John's, Laveen
1916-1956	Diocesan priests attended St. Lucy's from Immaculate Conception, Ajo
1957-1963 (closed)	Franciscans (Santa Barbara Province, Oakland, California) attended St. Lucy's from San Solano Missions, Topawa
1973-1985	Jesuits (California Province, Los Gatos, California) attended St. Lucy's from St. Michael's, Gila Bend
1986	Society of the Atonement (Garrison, New York) attended St. Lucy's from St. Michael's, Gila Bend
1987-1994	Sisters of St. Joseph of Carondelet (Los Angeles Province, Los Angeles, California) attended St. Lucy's from St. Michael's, Gila Bend
1995	Salvatorians (U.S.A. Province, Milwaukee, Wisconsin) attended St. Lucy's from St. Michael's, Gila Bend
1996-2000	Congregation of Holy Cross (Midwest Province, Notre Dame, Indiana) attended St. Lucy's from St. Michael's, Gila Bend
2001-present	Diocesan priests have attended St. Lucy's from St. Michael's, Gila Bend
