Inclusive dates: 1824-1994

Volume: Approximately 2 cubic feet

Description: 7 collections include Native Catholic records.

/1 "Edward W. Cochems Photographs, SD-R16"

Inclusive dates: ca. 1919-ca. 1949

Volume: 10 folders

Description: 88 prints and negatives by Cochems (1874-1949) of San Antonio de Pala, San Juan Capistrano, San Gabriel Arcángel, San Luis Rey de Francia, Santa Barbara, and Santa Ysabel Missions in California.

/2 "Don Meadows Papers, MS-R001"

Inclusive dates: 1824-1994 (bulk ca. 1850-ca. 1950)

Volume: Approximately 63 folders

Description: Mostly printed ephemera, clippings, correspondence, photographs, and research notes, re: La Purísima Concepción de Maria Santísima, San Diego de Alcalá, San Fernando Rey de España, San Gabriel Arcángel, San Juan Capistrano, San Luis Rey de Francia, Santa Barbara, Santa Inés, and Santa Ysabel Missions in California and Baja California, Mexico; notable correspondents include Monsignor Francis Weber, 1966 and Bernard Fontana, 1986.

/3 "McPherson Postcard Collection, MS-R07"

Inclusive dates: ca. 1907-ca. 1962

Volume: 56 folders

Description: Postcards, some inscribed, including most Franciscan Indian missions in California, and San Xavier del Bac Mission, Tucson, Arizona.

/4 "Richard Egan Manuscript Maps of Orange County, MS-R72" [Richard Egan (1842-1923)]

Inclusive dates: ca. 1878-1879

Volume: 1 map

Description: Includes 1 plat map (42 x 42 cm.) of San Juan Capistrano Mission, San Juan Capistrano, California.

/5 "California vacation albums, MS-R67"

Inclusive dates: 1900-1924

Volume: 22 pages of photographs and 1 tintype

Description: Albums of photographic prints, postcards, and tintypes with several of California missions.

/6 "Tubbs Family Photographs, MS-R53"
