History: St. Joseph Church is a non-Indian parish that is believed to have had a few American Indian parishioners. A Catholic Indian Club met at St. Joseph's, ca. 1957-1980s. It was organized by Etta "Mrs. Chester" Roubideaux (Brulé, Rosebud Reservation, South Dakota) of Paramount, California, who also served as club president, ca. 1957-1960s.
