Description: Photographs of San Diego de Alcalá Mission, San Diego, California and San Xavier del Bac Mission, Tucson, Arizona by Albert Bartlett (1887-1966).

Description: By landscape architect Ralph D. Cornell (1908-1972), re: color transparencies of Franciscan Indian missions in California.

Description: By Joseph Le Compte Davis (1864-1957): 2 ink drawings of San Juan Bautista and San Miguel Arcángel Missions and 20 watercolors, 5 blue-tinted photographs, and 1 black and white photograph of various Franciscan missions in California.
