History: St. Anthony Church is a non-Indian parish that had a few Pomo Indian parishioners through ca. 1920

1864-1904	Diocesan priests established and administered St. Anthony Church
1904-1940 (closed)	Capuchins (Irish Province, Dublin, Ireland) administered St. Anthony's
1967-present	Diocesan priests reopened and have administered St. Anthony's

Diocesan priests from St. Anthony's attended St. Mary of the Angels Mission (Pomo), Ukiah, 1866-1887 (became a parish); partially Indian

Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans:

Inclusive dates: 1904-1940, 1967-present

Volume: Few entries among several volumes

Description: Sacramental records for American Indian parishioners of St. Anthony Church and St. Mary of the Angels Mission.
