Inclusive dates: 1946

Volume: At least 1 photograph

Description: Arranged by subject area; includes 1 image online of Catholic priests and Ute Indians by an unidentified church.

/6 "Theodore Hetzel Photograph Collection, Collection P 003"

Inclusive dates: Between 1954-1989

Volume: Few photographs

Description: Director of the Indian Rights Association; arranged by location and includes missions, churches, cemeteries, and American Indians.

/7 Southwest Postcards Collection, Collection M 195"

Inclusive dates: Between 1903-1999

Volume: Few postcards

Description: Includes black and white and color postcards of St. Augustine Mission, Isleta, New Mexico.

Microfilm Collections

/8 "Mexican Archives of New Mexico, Collection I 005"

Inclusive dates: 1821-1846

Volume: Few documents within 43 reels of microfilm

Description: Records of the Mexican Republic in New Mexico; includes Franciscan missions and American Indians; finding aid available.

/9 "Spanish Archives of New Mexico, Collection I 004"

Inclusive dates: 1621-1821

Volume: Few documents within 22 reels of microfilm

Description: Records of New Spain in New Mexico; includes Franciscan missions and American Indians; finding aid available.
