History: The Sisters of Mercy were founded in Dublin, Ireland in 1831 and made their first U.S. foundation in 1843. The Sisters of Mercy have administered the following provinces and jurisdictions, which at least in part, have included Indian missions and parishes in what is now the United States:

1876-1903	Regional Community of Burlingame, Burlingame, California
1878-1907 (transferred to Regional Community of Omaha)	Province of Omaha, Omaha, Nebraska
1897-1947	Regional Community of St. Louis, St. Louis, Missouri
1975-1976	Regional Community of Vermont, Burlington, Vermont
