1732-1736	Pére Guymonneau, S.J. established and administered St.
	Francis Xavier Church (Illinois and Métis) until his
	death in 1736
1736-1763	Other Jesuits served the parish intermittently
1769	Diocesan priests succeeded the Jesuits in serving the
