History: The Benedictine Sisters of Immaculate Conception Monastery were established in 1867 and taught at the following schools serving American Indian students:

1878-1882	Standing Rock Reservation Schools (Hunkpapa), Dakota Territory
1933-1963 (transferred to Queen of Peace Monastery, Belcourt, North Dakota)	St. Ann Mission School (Métis and Ojibwa), Belcourt, Turtle Mountain Reservation, North Dakota
