History: The Ursulines, Congregation of Paris, were founded in Italy in 1535 and made their first U.S. foundation in New Orleans in 1727. The Mount St. Joseph Motherhouse administered the following schools in New Mexico, which included some Navajo Indian students:

1919-1990s	Sacred Heart School, Farmington
1919-1950s	Waterflow School and Academy, Waterflow
1919-1960 (closed)	St. Rose School, Blanco
