History: The Diocese of Alexandria was established in 1968. Previously it was part of the dioceses of Alexandria-Shreveport, 1968-1976; Natchitoches, 1910-1968; and New Orleans, 1853-1910. The Alexandria Diocese includes a few Native American Catholics, at least some of who are Apalachee Indians that moved to Rapides Parish in 1763.

Holdings of Native Catholic records are unknown. However, the website states that no sacramental records for Rapides Parish are available before 1895.
