History: St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church is a non-Indian parish created by the consolidation of St. George Church, Bark River, and other nearby parishes. Diocesan priests from St. George's had attended St. Kateri Church/ St. James Mission (Potawatomi), Harris/ Hannahville.

History of St. Kateri Church

1946, 1955-1960	Jesuits (Detroit Province, Detroit, Michigan) established and attended St. James Mission from Escanaba
1947-1955	Jesuits attended St. James from Marquette
1960-1972	Capuchins attended St. James from Sacred Heart, Baraga
1972-1976	Became a parish and was renamed; diocesan priests administered St. Kateri Church
1976-1982 (closed)	Diocesan priests attended St. Kateri's from St. George's, Bark River
