History: Sacred Heart Church is a non-Indian parish that had a number of Ojibwa Indian parishioners, ca. 1884-1920s.

1884-1888	Diocesan priests established and attended Sacred Heart Mission from St. Mary's, Sault Sainte Marie
1889-1891	Diocesan priests attended Sacred Heart from St. Ann's, Mackinac Island
1891-1920s (no longer Indian)	Became a parish; diocesan priests have administered Sacred Heart Church
