History: Founded in 1845, the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary of Monroe, Michigan, have served at or staffed the following Indian missions and schools:

1974-1977	Red Cloud Indian School (Oglala), Pine Ridge, Pine Ridge Reservation, South Dakota
1974-present	St. Stephen Mission School, (Arapaho and Shoshoni), St. Stephens, Wind River Reservation, Wyoming
1975-present	St. Patrick Mission (Apache, Caddo, Comanche, Kiowa, and Wichita), Anadarko, Oklahoma
1977-present	Holy Rosary Mission (Oglala), Pine Ridge, Pine Ridge Reservation, South Dakota
1979-1982	St. Agnes Mission (Oglala), Manderson, Pine Ridge Reservation, South Dakota
