History: St. Stephen Church and School has had a number of Ojibwa Indian Parishioners, 1960s-present. During the 1970s, Sister Irene (Kathryn) De Marrais (Sisseton and Wahpeton, 1915-2004) of the Sisters of the Divine Savior served the parish with home visitations and teaching part-time in the school.

Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans:

Inclusive dates: 1960s-present

Volume: .6 cubic foot

Description: The records at St. Stephen Church are not organized according to a classification scheme. Consequently, description is by record type.

- A. Sacramental records, 1960s-present, .1 cubic foot
- B. Student files, 1960s-present, .5 cubic foot: Arranged alphabetically by Students' surname; in 1980-1981, the files were incomplete beginning ca. 1970
