1904-present	Jesuits (formerly Turin and California; now Oregon Province, Portland, Oregon) established and administered Church of the Little Flower (Siksika), Blackfeet Reservation
1984-1988	Diocesan priests from Christ King, Missoula, assisted with administration
2004-present	Christian Brothers (Midwest Province) have administered De La Salle Blackfeet Middle School at Little Flower

Jesuits from Little Flower have attended the following school and mission among the Siksika Indians on the Blackfeet Reservation:

1904-present	Blackfeet Government Indian School, Browning
1954-present	St. Mary, Queen of the World Mission, Babb
