After 1920-1976	Capuchins (St. Joseph Province, Detroit, Michigan) attended Blessed Sacrament from St. Labre's, Ashland
1970-1981	School Sisters of St Francis (U.S. Province, Milwaukee, Wisconsin) assisted in administrating Blessed Sacrament
1976-2004	Capuchins (St. Joseph Province, Detroit, Michigan) administered Blessed Sacrament
2004-present	A deacon has served as Pastoral Administrator of Blessed Sacrament
