Inclusive dates: 1940, 1947-1948, n.d.

Volume: At least 20 photographs

Description: By Rollin H. McKay (1878-1960), a professional photographer; includes: Joe La Moose (Salish), n.d., Chief Charlo (Salish), n.d., Chief Joseph (Nez Perce), n.d., St. Ignatius Mission, St. Ignatius, Montana, ca. 1940, n.d., and St. Mary's Mission, Stevensville, Montana, 1947-1948, n.d.

/2 "Book of Baptisms/ Functions, Helena, Hellgate, and Frenchtown, Mont., Collection 024"

Inclusive dates: 1866-1907

Volume: Few entries within 1 volume and 1 reel of microfilm

Description: Records (copies) of baptisms, confirmations, marriages, and deaths, which may include a few American Indians.

/3 "Boos, Edward H., Collection, Mss. 346"

Inclusive dates: ca. 1900-1908

Volume: At least 5 photographs

Description: Joe La Moose (1846-1931), wife, and child (Salish), unidentified family portrait near St. Ignatius Mission, St. Ignatius, Montana, and Christian shrine in thick of vegetation, near St. Ignatius Mission.

/4 "Voget, Fred W., Collection, Mss. 318"

Inclusive dates: n.d.

Volume: 2 photographs

Description: By ethnographer Fred W. Voget (1913-1997): numbers 318(VI) 367 and 318(VI) 369, Crow Indians and Our Lady of Loretto Mission, Crow Reservation, Montana.
