History: In 1620, the Diocese of Durango was erected for California, Chihuahua, Florida, Louisiana, New Mexico, and Sonora from portions of the Diocese of Guadalajara. Durango and its predecessors administered the following Indian missions in what is now Arizona, California, New Mexico, and west Texas (Eastern states not included):
