History: In 1548, the Diocese of Guadalajara (now the Archdiocese of Guadalajara) was erected from portions of the Diocese of Michoacán (now the Archdiocese of Morelia). Guadalajara and its predecessors administered the following Indian missions in what is now the United States (New Mexico):

1598-1680, 1692-present (Guadalajara, 1598-1620)	St. John the Baptist Church/ San Juan de Los Caballeros Mission (Tewa), Ohkay Owingeh/ San Juan Pueblo, San Juan Reservation, New Mexico
1598-1680, 1694-present (Guadalajara, 1598-1620)	San Diego de Alcalá de Tesuque/ San Lorenzo de Tesuque Mission (Tewa), Tesuque Pueblo, Tesuque Reservation, New Mexico
1598-1680, 1700s-present (Guadalajara, 1598-1620)	San Diego de la Concepción Mission (Jemez), Jémez Pueblo/ Walatowa, New Mexico
1598-1639 (closed) (Guadalajara, 1598-1620)	San José de Giusewa Mission (Jemez), Jemez Springs, New Mexico
1607-1680, 1771-present (Guadalajara, 1598-1620)	St. Dominic/ Santo Domingo Church/ Santo Domingo de Guzmán Mission (Santo Domingo), Santo Domingo Pueblo, Santo Domingo Reservation, New Mexico
1613-1680, 1710-present (Guadalajara, 1598-1620)	St. Augustine/ San Agustín de la Isleta Church (Tiwa), Isleta Pueblo, Isleta Reservation, New Mexico
1613-1680, 1694-present (Guadalajara, 1598-1620)	San Francisco de Nambé Mission (Tewa), Nambé Pueblo, Nambe Reservation, New Mexico
1617-1680, 1694-present (Guadalajara, 1598-1620)	San Ildefonso Mission (Tewa), San Ildefonso Pueblo, San Ildefonso Reservation, New Mexico
