History: The Diocese of Sonora was erected in 1779 for Sonora and Alto and Baja California from portions of the Diocese of Durango (now the Archdiocese of Durango). Later, the Sonora Diocese was renamed the Diocese of Hermosillo and then elevated to the Archdiocese of Hermosillo. Hermosillo and its predecessors administered the following Indian missions in what is now the United States (Arizona and California):
