History: St. Thomas the Apostle Church is a non-Indian parish that has had a number of parishioners of American Indian descent.

1754-1772	Franciscans (Santo Evangelico Province, Mexico City, Mexico) established and administered St. Thomas the Apostle/ Santo Tomás Apóstol/ Santo Tomás de Abiquiú Mission (Mestizos and various)
1772-1846 (no longer Indian)	Franciscans attended St. Thomas from Santa Clara, Santa Clara
