| 1629-1680 (closed) | Fray Juan Ramirez, O.F.M. established and Franciscans (Santo Evangelico Province, Mexico City, Mexico) administered San Esteban del Rey de Ácoma Mission (Acoma) |
| 1699-1848 | Franciscans reestablished and administered San Estevan |
| 1848-1854 | Diocesan priests attended San Estevan from San Francisco, Santa Fe |
| 1854-1856, 1887-1888 | Diocesan priests attended San Estevan from San Augustin, Isleta Pueblo |
| 1858-1884 | Diocesan priests attended San Estevan from Nuestra Señora de los Dolores, Seboyeta |
| 1885-1892 | Diocesan priests attended San Estevan from San Rafael, Milan |
| 1892-1900 | Diocesan priests attended San Estevan from Nuestra Señora de los Dolores, Seboyeta |
| 1900-1920 | Diocesan priests attended San Estevan from Sacred Heart, Gallup |
| 1930-1950 | Franciscans (formerly St. John the Baptist; now Our Lady of Guadalupe Province, Albuquerque, New Mexico) attended San Estevan from St. Joseph's, Laguna Pueblo |
| 1950-1966 | Franciscans attended San Estevan from St. Joseph's, San Fidel |
| 1966-present | Became a parish; Franciscans have administered San Estevan del Rey Church |
