Description: Parish sacramental records (baptisms, marriages, and burials) and diligencias matrimoniales [prenuptial investigations] of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe (New Mexico and El Paso, Texas); from Archdiocese of Santa Fe Archives, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

/2 "Archives of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe, Series A"

Inclusive dates: ca. 1694-1956

Volume: 31 reels of microfilm

Description: Parish sacramental records (baptisms, marriages, and burials) of the Archdiocese of Santa Fe microfilmed by the Genealogical Society of Utah, Salt Lake City, Utah; from Archdiocese of Santa Fe Archives, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

Description: Records of land titles and grants in colonial New Mexico; includes Indian missions of New Mexico and El Paso, Texas; from New Mexico State Records Center and Archives, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

Inclusive dates: 1821-1621

Volume: Less than 1% within 22 reels of microfilm

Description: Includes correspondence and reports between officials of church and state, re: Indian missions of New Mexico and El Paso, Texas; from New Mexico State Records Center and Archives, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

/5 "Mexican Archives of New Mexico"

Inclusive dates: 1821-1846

Volume: Less than 1% within 42 reels of microfilm

Description: Includes correspondence and reports between officials of church and state, re: Indian missions of New Mexico and El Paso, Texas; from New Mexico State Records Center and Archives, Santa Fe, New Mexico.

/6 "Territorial Archives of New Mexico"

Inclusive dates: Ca. 1821

Volume: Less than 1% within 189 reels of microfilm

Description: Includes correspondence and reports between officials of church and state, re: Indian missions of New Mexico; from New Mexico State Records Center and Archives, Santa Fe, New Mexico.
