History:

1613-1680, 1710-1848	Franciscans (Santo Evangelico Province, Mexico City, Mexico) established and administered St. Augustine Church/ San Agustín de la Isleta Mission (Tiwa), Islata Pueblo, which was disrupted by the 1680 Pueblo Revolt
1848-1960s, 1980-1998	Diocesan priests administered St. Augustine's
1887-1897, 1933-1936	A school was operated at the parish
1968-present	Canossian Daughters of Charity (United States Province, Albuquerque, New Mexico) have staffed St. Augustine's religious education program
1970-1980	Diocesan priests attended St. Augustine's from Ascension, Santa Fe
1998	Premonstratensians (St. Norbert's Abbey, De Pere, Wisconsin) administered St. Augustine's
1998-present	Franciscans (Our Lady of Guadalupe Province, Albuquerque, New Mexico) have administered St. Augustine's

Diocesan priests from St. Augustine's attended the following Indian missions:

1841-1852 (transferred to San Francisco, Santa Fe); 1854-1856 (transferred to Nuestra Senora de los Dolores, Seboyeta)	Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe de Halona Mission (Zuni), Halona, Zuni Reservation
1854-1856 (transferred to Nuestra Senora de los Dolores, Seboyeta)	San José Mission (Laguna), Laguna Pueblo, Laguna Reservation
1854-1856 (transferred to Nuestra Senora de los Dolores, Seboyeta), 1887-1888 (transferred to San Rafael, San Rafael)	San Estevan del Rey Mission (Acoma), Acoma Pueblo, Acoma Reservation

Holdings of Catholic-related records about Native Americans:

Inclusive dates: 1844-present

Volume: Approximately 4 cubic feet

Description: The records at St. Augustine Church are not arranged according to a classification scheme. Consequently, description is by record type.

Inclusive dates: ca. 1900-present

Volume: Several volumes and folders
