History: Our Lady of Sorrows/ Nuestra Señora de los Dolores Church, Seboyeta/ Cebolleta, is a non-Indian parish that is believed to include a number of parishioners of American Indian descent. Furthermore, diocesan priests from Our Lady of Sorrows attended the following Indian missions:

1858-1882 (transferred to San Rafael, Milan); 1894-1898 (transferred to Sacred Heart, Gallup)	Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe de Halona Mission (Zuni), Halona, Zuni Reservation
1858-1884 (transferred to San Rafael, Milan); 1892-1900 (transferred to Sacred Heart, Gallup)	San Estevan del Rey Mission (Acoma), Acoma Pueblo, Acoma Reservation
1858-1888 (transferred to San Rafael, Milan)	St. Joseph Chapel (Laguna), Laguna Pueblo, Laguna Reservation
