History: Our Lady of Guadalupe/ Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe/ San Fernando Church is a non-Indian parish. However, diocesan priests from Our Lady of Guadalupe have attended St. Jerome Mission (Tiwa), Taos Pueblo, 1852-present.

History of St. Jerome Mission

| 1887-1896 (closed?) | Diocesan priests established and staffed the Taos School (Tiwa), Taos Pueblo |
